DOG LICENSE:

All dog owners must license their dogs every year.

Rabies Vaccination Certificate is Required by Law to issue License.

***UPDATED KENNEL DOG LICENSE ORDINANCE:

Effective immediately, you must get Town Board approval to obtain your kennel license at a monthly town board meeting. A Kennel License is required for 6-12 dogs on site.

*** BUIL DING PERMITS ***: A land use permit is required for all new buildings (including Agricultural buildings), remodeling, etc. If you need a permit or are unsure if you need a permit for work being done - Call Building Inspector / Code Enforcement Officer,

FARMLAND PRESERVATION INFORMATION -

POWTS Special Assessment: Pursuant to Resolution Number 124-09, adopted by the Fond du Lac County Board of Supervisors on March 16, 2010, and effective on the 2016 property tax bill, Fond du Lac County will apply a special assessment fee of \$6.00 for each Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment System (POWTS) in Fond du Lac County. This annual fee is designed to cover the costs of information collection and administration of the POWTS program. If you are a tax-exempt organization (i.e. church or governmental unit), you will still receive the charge of \$6.00 per POWTS since this is a special assessment, not a tax. If you feel this information is in error, please call the Fond du Lac County Code Enforcement Office at 920-929-3139. Please leave your name, address of the property, phone number, and why you feel this assessment is in error.
